

Angel and Wiley have only heard rumors.


Earth's creatures are not yet aware of Whimsey World or any other world with human or any other sentient life.

We want thriving future for all!




"Hi! I am Angel. This is Wiley. We are Whimseys. Non-human creatures, just like you, from a world far, far away from Earth."


"We come to help all Earth creatures avoid early extinction. Stop damage to Earth."

While most adult humans appear to question whether or not to trust Angel and Wiley, many younger humans implicitly trust them.



"People of Earth, you are in great danger."


"Every day you continue to be selfish and shortsighted is another day closer to early extinction for human and many other creatures."

> "We, the Whimseys of Whimsey world, came oh so close to early extinction. To losing our world."


> "But we changed. Worked together. Thought of our future. Used our great creativity."

But they are not succeeding. Without major change, they will witness early extinction on Earth. Great damage to Earth.


#### "Wiley, I am really confused."

"maybe we attack your


world"

Too many see Angel as just a strange creature from a strange world.


Angel is in anguish. Wiley is just angry at the stupidity and selfishness.

Very quickly, the pace to early extinction quickens. More and more negative human effects get larger. Combine with other negative effects.


More and more humans see what is happening. Most humans still unwilling to get off current bad future path. Unwilling to get on surviving and thriving path.

Early extinction is here. Great damage to Earth is here.


"This is beyond terrible."


> "You know your fate." "We only suggest that you do as much good as you can for as long as you can." "The end is coming quickly."

Many cry out to Angel and Wiley for more help. More time.




As their final act, Angel and Wiley send out their final message to all Earth creatures.

They sadly turn for home. Back to a home with a thriving future. Back to Whimsey World. But they can not resist pausing their journey home.


They turn around and take one last sad look back at Earth.
